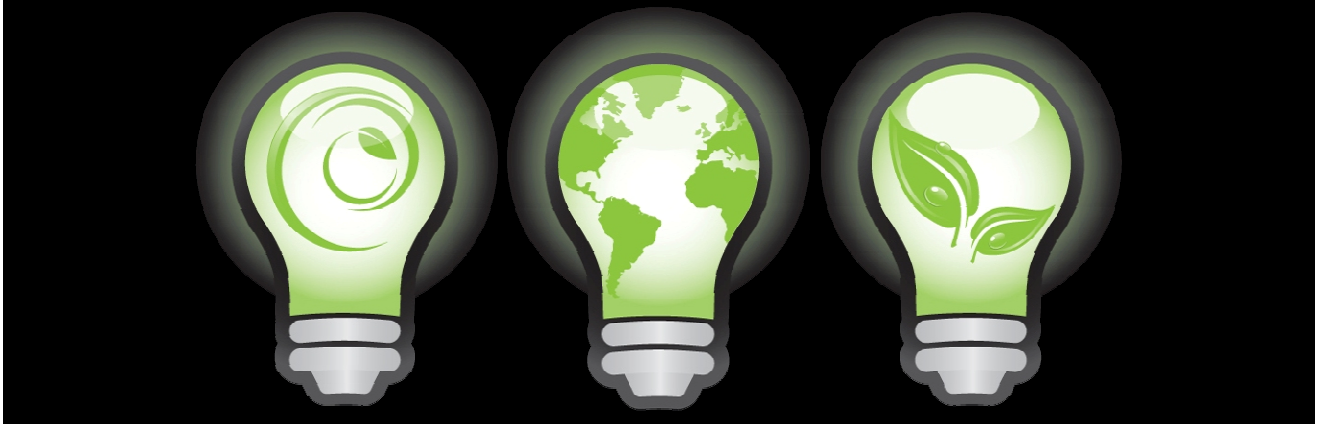


We're Getting "FIT:" Faculty and Industry Talking
